Rationale

A uniform policy reinforces in students a pride in their own appearance, instils recognition of themselves as an integral part of the school community, and assists in developing pride in representing their school. Issues of safety, health and equality, and expense are also factors that underpin the need for a school uniform. Uniforms help students to prepare for when they leave school and may have to dress smartly or wear a uniform.

<u>Aims</u>

To promote equality amongst all students.

To further develop a sense of pride in, and identification with our school.

To provide smart, durable clothing that is cost effective and practical for our school environment. To maintain and enhance the positive image of the school in the community.

The uniform policy applies during school hours, while travelling to and from school, and when students are representing their school e.g. excursions and other school events.

New Uniform

New school uniforms with the school logo must now be purchased online. There are a range of sizes kept at the school shop for those pupils who wish to try on the clothes before ordering..

Policy

The uniform policy, including details of uniform items and places of purchase will be revised and published each year

Non-compliance

Students who do not comply with the dress code will be asked to remove the offending items. If they continue to wear the offending items a letter will be sent home to inform their parents. Repeated non-compliance will result in a meeting with parents to resolve the issue.

This policy will be reviewed as part of the school's review cycle in September 2023

EYFS Foundation Stage

WINTER UNIFORM (from November break to the start of Term 3)

Physical Education uniform:

BOYS AND GIRLS: Short-sleeved white T-shirt, school tracksuit, white trainers and white socks.

SUMMER UNIFORM (from the start of Term 3 to November break)

Physical Education uniform:

BOYS AND GIRLS: Navy blue and white shorts and short-sleeved white T-shirt, white trainers and white socks.

<u>ALSO</u>

Striped overall to protect uniform

KEY STAGE 1: (Years 1 and 2)

WINTER UNIFORM (from November break to the start of Term 3)

Official uniform:

BOYS: White shirt, grey long trousers, school tie, navy blue knitted jacket, navy socks and black or navy blue shoes*.

<u>GIRLS</u>: White shirt, checked pinafore dress, school tie, navy blue knitted jacket, navy blue tights or socks and black or navy blue shoes*.

Physical Education uniform:

BOYS AND GIRLS: Short-sleeved T-shirt, school tracksuit, white trainers and white socks.

SUMMER UNIFORM (from the start of Term 3 to November break)

Official uniform:

BOYS: White polo shirt, shorts, navy blue socks, black or navy blue shoes*. **GIRLS:** White polo shirt, navy blue skort navy, blue socks, black or navy blue shoes*.

Physical Education uniform:

BOYS AND GIRLS: Navy blue and white shorts and short-sleeved white and navy T-shirt, white trainers and white socks.

PLEASE NOTE THAT TRAINERS ARE ONLY PERMITTED ON P.E. DAYS. HOWEVER, WE DO ENCOURAGE CHILDREN TO BRING TRAINERS AND CHANGE INTO THEM AT PATIO TIMES SO AS TO PROTECT THEIR SHOES AND THE PITCH:



KEY STAGE 2 (Year 3 – Year 6)

WINTER UNIFORM (from November break to the start of Term 3)

Official uniform:

BOYS: White shirt, long, grey trousers, school tie, navy blue knitted jacket, navy blue socks and black or navy blue school shoes*.

GIRLS: White shirt, checked skirt, school tie, navy blue knitted jacket, navy blue tights or socks and black or navy blue school shoes*.

Physical Education uniform:

BOYS AND GIRLS: Short-sleeved white T-shirt, school tracksuit, white trainers and white socks.

SUMMER UNIFORM (from the start of Term 3 to November break)

Official uniform:

BOYS: White polo shirt, navy blue shorts, navy blue socks and black or navy blue school shoes*. **GIRLS:** White polo shirt, navy blue skort, blue socks, blue or black school shoes*.

Physical Education uniform:

BOYS AND GIRLS: Navy blue and white shorts and short-sleeved white and navy blue T-shirt, white trainers and white socks.

KEY STAGE 3 and 4 (Year 7 – Year 11)

WINTER UNIFORM (from November break to the start of Term 3)

Official uniform:

BOYS: White shirt, long, grey trousers, school tie, black blazer, navy blue socks and black or navy blue school shoes*.

<u>GIRLS</u>: White shirt, grey skirt, school tie, navy blue knitted jacket, navy blue tights, black or navy blue school shoes*.

Physical Education uniform:

BOYS AND GIRLS: Short-sleeved white T-shirt, school tracksuit, white trainers and white socks.

SUMMER UNIFORM (from the start of Term 3 to November break)

Official uniform:

BOYS: White polo shirt, navy blue shorts, navy blue socks and black or navy blue school shoes*.

<u>GIRLS</u>: White polo shirt, navy blue skort, navy blue socks, black or navy blue school shoes*.

Physical Education uniform:

BOYS AND GIRLS: Short-sleeved white and navy blue T-shirt, navy blue shorts, white socks and white trainers.

PLEASE NOTE THAT TRAINERS ARE ONLY PERMITTED ON P.E. DAYS. HOWEVER, WE DO ENCOURAGE CHILDREN TO BRING TRAINERS AND CHANGE INTO THEM AT PATIO TIMES SO AS TO PROTECT THEIR SHOES AND THE PITCH:

EYFS - KEY STAGE 4 (FS1 to Year 11)

Jewellery, make-up, accessories and other items

Items permitted:

A watch Plain stud earrings Discreet hair accessories which match uniform (Blue/white/black..) Navy blue scarf (when required)

Items not permitted:

Bracelets Rings Necklaces (Discreet chains/necklaces worn for personal/religious reasons should not be visible) Piercings (apart from earrings) Visible tattoos Make-up Coloured nail polish Non-uniform sweatshirts Hoodies *Brightly coloured/flashing trainers *Boots, flip-flops, sandals, open toed shoes, high heels. Mini skirts (uniform skirts should be no shorter than just above the knee)"

> <u>* Please also note that all school shoes should be smart, polishable shoes, not</u> <u>pumps, casual shoes or sports shoes.</u>

All valuable items should be removed for P.E. lessons for safety reasons. The school cannot take responsibility for any loss of or damage to such items.

KEY STAGE 5 (Y12 and 13)

Our Sixth form students are able to follow the uniform policy of Key Stage 3 and Key Stage 4 If they choose to do so, they must ensure that they wear the **complete uniform**, avoiding any mixing with non-uniform items.or they can come in elegant business dress, providing it resembles in some way the school uniform.

With their winter uniform, students are also permitted to wear a school sweatshirt, with their house logo on the back

An example would be:

- White polo, shirt, blouse or smart top
- Navy, grey or black trousers or skirt
- Navy, grey or black black jumper/cardigan/smart jacket if required
- Smart black or navy shoes

Please note that jeans and trainers are not permitted

Sixth Form students may also wear discreet make up and jewellery at school.
